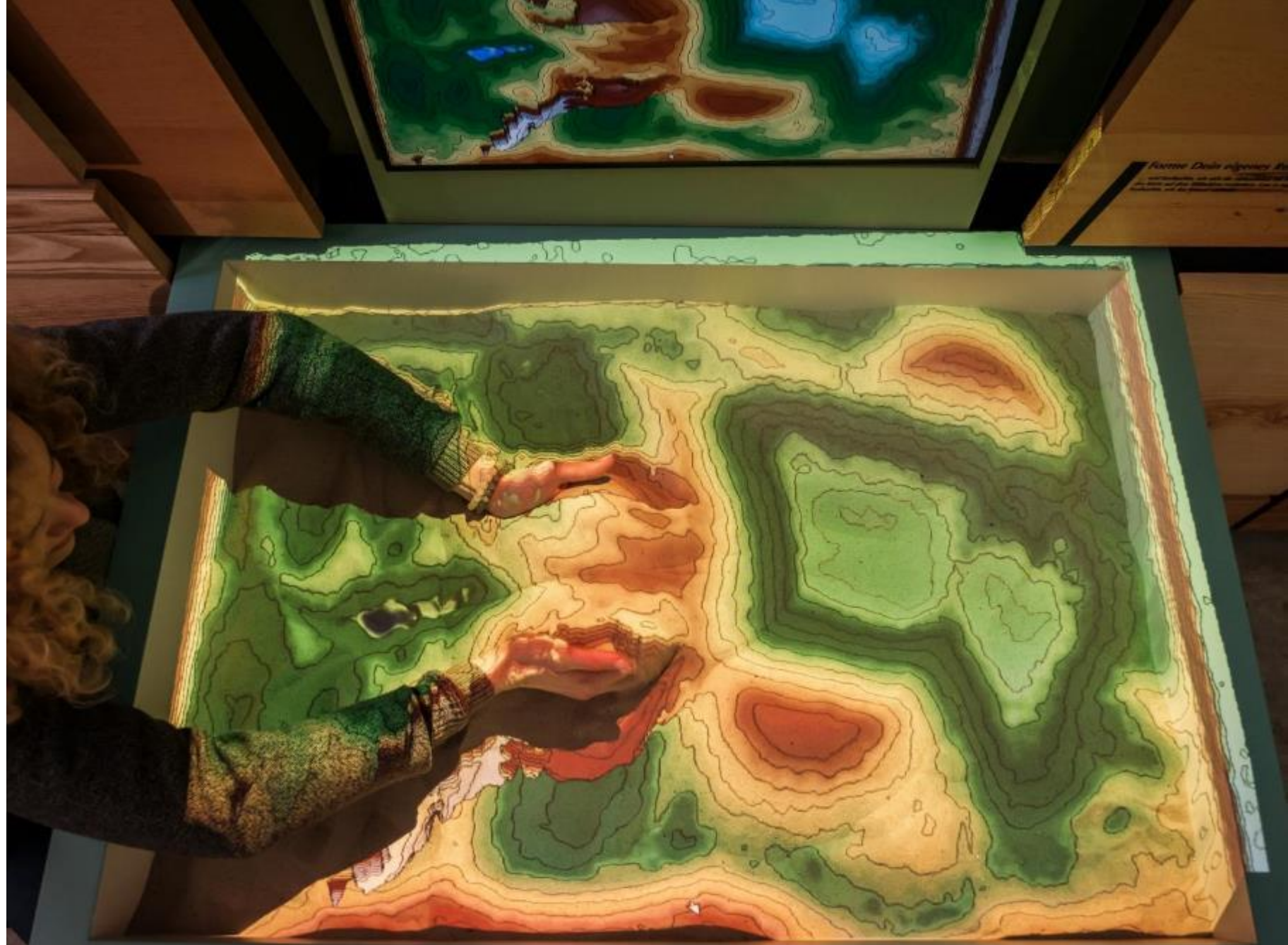

Length: 4,9 km

Time: 2 h

Difficulty: average
